

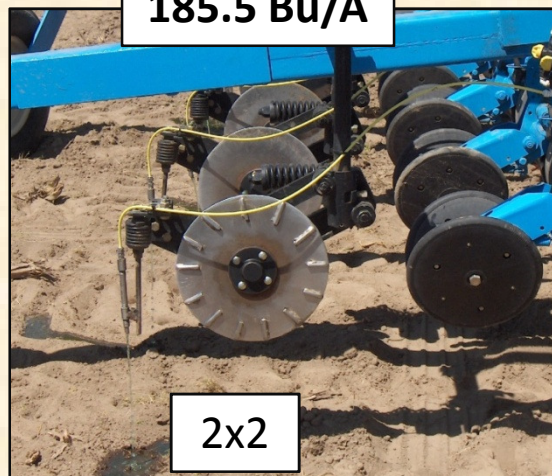


Where should I put it???

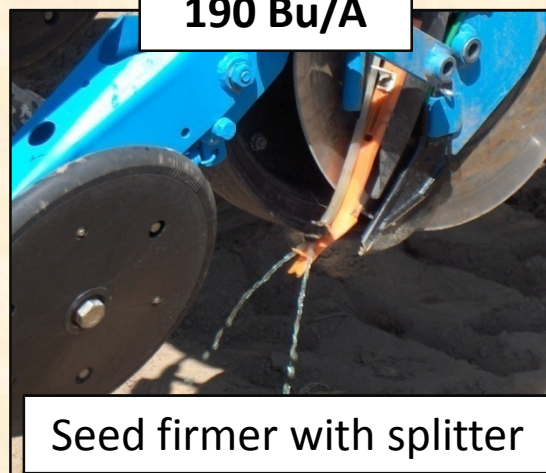


My **LIQUID** planter-applied corn fertilizer that is.

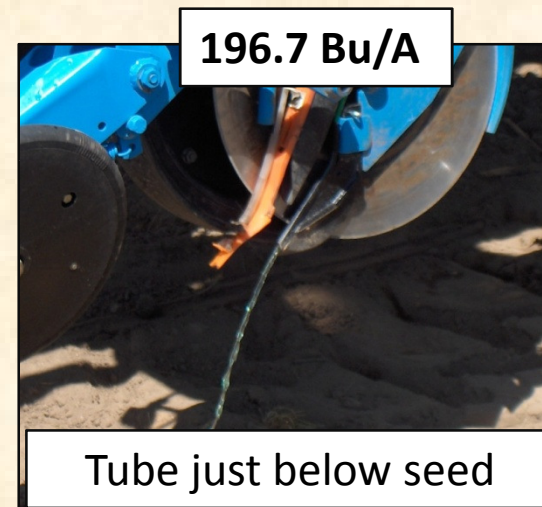
In a replicated research plot test at the *North Central Research Station*, several different fertilizer placement options were compared for effect on corn yield. Fertilizer rate was 3 gal/A **Pro-Germinator™** + 5 gal/A **Sure-K™** + 2 qt/A **Micro 500™**.



Good for application with nitrogen solutions, but too far from seed for best root access of P, K and micros.



Splitter gives some seed safety from high-salt fertilizers, which is not necessary for LIQUID. And on closer inspection it was observed that the fertilizer is mostly placed *above* the seed.



Seemingly the best placement for the low-salt, highly usable LIQUID plant nutrition. Early root development has easy access to the fertilizer. The seed firmer is still recommended for help with seed placement though.
