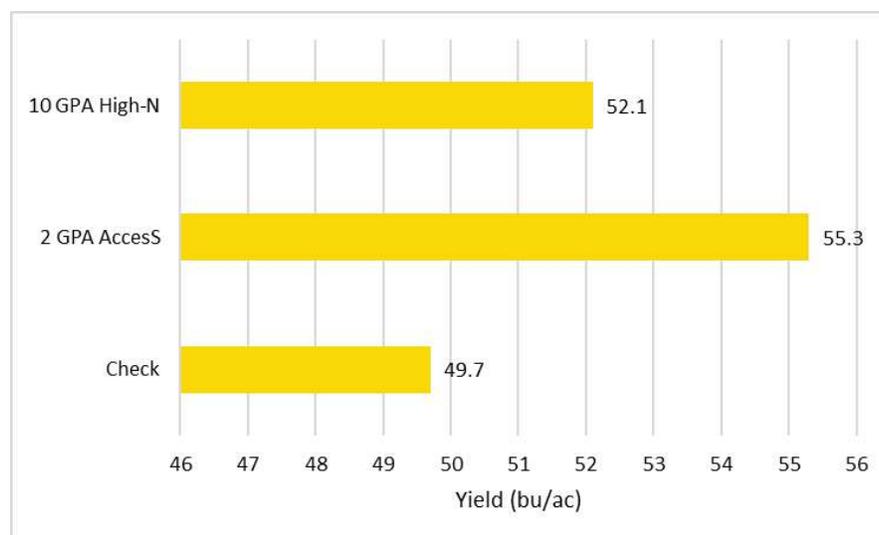

In soils where sulphur levels are limited, applying sulphur can help optimize nutrient balance and support higher yield potential while maintaining overall crop health.
